In this surgery, in the vestibular and lingual area of tooth 36 and 37 the gingiva is apically repositioned to facilitate the prosthetic procedures planned. While in the buccal area a split thickness flap is needed for the apical positioning, in the lingual area a full thickness flap is appropriate.

Apically Positioned Flap Continuing Dental Education The apically positioned flap was first designed and described by Friedman in 1962. The flap was elevated by an internal bevel incision and two vertical incisions. Vertical incisions were used to outline the surgical site and made at mesial and distal line angles of terminal teeth.

The flap was positioned apically and was sutured around the healing cap. The vertical releasing incisions were sutured with simple interrupted sutures and a periosteal anchoring suture was placed at the base of the flap [Figures [Figures 1- 5]. 5]. Periodontal dressing was placed if necessary and routine post-operative instructions and medications were given.

Evaluating the clinical and esthetic outcome of apically ... Apically positioned flap combined with a collagen matrix results in a more apical position of the MGJ at sites with or without GBR. Following a coronal shift during the first month after the apical positioning of the flap, the level of the MGJ remained stable.
