The Excel IF Statement tests a given condition and returns one value for a TRUE result and another value for a FALSE result. For example, if sales total more than \$5,000, then return a \"Yes\" for Bonus - Otherwise, return a \"No\" for Bonus. We can also use the IF function to evaluate a single function, or we can include several IF functions in one formula.

It tests a condition to see if it's true or false and then carries out a specific set of instructions based on the results. For example, inputting an IF-THEN in Excel, you can test if a specific cell is greater than 900.

So you need to use DATAVALUE function and let Excel think that it is a Date value. For example: DATEVALUE ("11/3/2018"). Now we can write down the following IF formula with Dates. =IF (B1<DATEVALUE ("11/3/2018"),"good","bad") The above excel IF formula will check the date value in Cell B1 if it is less than another specified date (11/3/2018), if the test is TRUE, then return "good", otherwise return "bad".

The first field, Set cell:, will contain the desired result. In our example, cell B5 is already selected. The second field, To value:, is the desired result.

To enter data into a cell, just click in the cell and begin typing. What you type also displays in the Formula Bar. When entering dates, Excel defaults to the current year if the year portion of the date is not entered. You may edit cell contents from the Formula bar, or from directly inside the cell.

Data validation rules are triggered when a user adds or changes a cell value. In this formula, the LEFT function is used to extract the first 3 characters of the input in C5. Next, the EXACT function is used to compare the extracted text to the text hard-coded into the formula, \"MX-\". EXACT performs a case-sensitive comparison.
