The international institutionalization of community policing during roughly the past 25 years has been so successful that in many countries this police model is now regarded as 'the organizing paradigm' (Bayley and Shearing, 1996; Oliver and Bartgis, 1998) and 'the most important development' in public policing (Skogan and Roth, 2004). Despite its widespread popularity, this police concept has attracted much scepticism and criticism.
