For Level 2 Activation, trauma team members are: 1. Emergency physician (present within 15 minutes of patient's arrival) 2. Two emergency department RNs 3. One ICU RN 4. One Med/Surg RN 5. Respiratory therapist 6. Radiology technician 7. Laboratory technician 8. Emergency department UA 9. Security 10. Patient Care Supervisor 11. ED UA/WC

TRAUMA ALERT: TEAM ACTIVATION PROTOCOL

The envelopes contain Job Action Sheets with specific duties and responsibilities to be accomplished immediately by key personnel when the Emergency Management Plan is activated. The Job Action Sheets are at the end of the Mass Casualty Incident Plan and outline duties for: DMO/ED Senior Attending Physician ED Administrator/ Nursing Supervisor

Emergency Management Plan For Mass Casualty Incidents

Obtains and secures the Emergency Medical Services Transport records Documents trauma team activation times and response times for the trauma surgeon, and other MD specialists on the flow sheet Controls the admission of students into the room, assigns tasks.

Successful Implementation of Electronic Trauma ...

In 2012, Tarrant County's Level I trauma center adopted the use of an electronic medical record (EMR). The trauma center's emergency department had approximately 100,000 annual patient visits and admitted over 2500 injured patients. Prior to instituting the EMR, trauma resuscitations wer e recorded on a paper flow sheet and compliance
