Because the Rule 60 motion is filed in the district court, and because Fed. R. App. P. 1 (a)(2) says that when the appellate rules provide for filing a motion in the district court, "the procedure must comply with the practice of the district court," the rule provides that the 10-day period is computed using Fed. R. Civ. P. 6 (a).
