Short Stories. A short story is a short work of fiction (fiction is imaginary literature in the form of written language). Think of them as “snack-size” versions of novels. There are 5 elements of a short story (they also apply to novels, such as “The Hobbit” by J.R.R. Tolkien).

The story's anti-war message is conveyed in several ways. First, Bradbury gave the short story the title of Sara Teasdale's anti-war poem "There Will Come Soft Rains" first published in 1918 during World War I and the 1918 flu pandemic. As in Teasdale's poem, Bradbury's story is devoid of human beings since they have all been killed.
