The literature scenario was basically divided in two categories: some of the most influential authors were supportive of the socialist State separated from the "capitalist" Federal Republic of Germany; yet there was also a circle of writers that felt the desire for German unity, as evidenced by those who firmly supported the idea of the existence of a shared culture between East and West that could not be separated by boundaries nor politics.
