Payments for environmental services (also known as payments for ecosystem services or PES), are payments to farmers or landowners who have agreed to take certain actions to manage their land or watersheds to provide an ecological service. As the payments provide incentives to land owners and managers, PES is a market-based mechanism, similar to subsidies and taxes, to encourage the conservation of natural resources.

Payments for environmental services (PES) refers to a system whereby beneficiaries of environmental services enter into voluntary agreements with land managers to support the adoption of practices expected to result in an increased supply of positive environmental externalities over a baseline, or “business-as-usual”, case.

International discussions on reducing emissions from deforestation and forest degradation (REDD+) foresee payment for environmental services (PES) schemes as an important mechanism to provide local incentives for the conservation and enhancement of carbon stocks. There are concerns, however, about the potential impacts of REDD+ and PES on local livelihoods.

## The Livelihood Impacts of Payments for Environmental ...

Payments are ideally subject to the evidence of the provision of the ecosystem service (output-based payments) and should address additionality concerns to reduce the cost of policy implementation. However, the output or results-based payment might be difficult to assess or require a long time-lag for monitoring and verification (e.g. changes in quality of water or reduced risk of flooding).

## Payments for ecosystem services

Since 1997, nearly one million hectares of forest in Costa Rica have been part of these 'payments for ecosystem services' (PES) schemes at one time or another. Meanwhile, forest cover has returned to over 50 per cent of the country's land area, from a low of just over 20 per cent in the 1980s.

Costa Rica pioneered the use of the payments for environmental services (PES) approach in developing countries by establishing a formal, country-wide program of payments, the PSA program. The PSA program has worked hard to develop mechanisms to charge the users of environmental services for the services they

The potential impacts of payments for environmental services (PES) and protected areas (PAs) on environmental outcomes and local livelihoods in developing countries are contentious and have been widely debated. The available evidence is sparse, with few rigorous evaluations of the environmental and social impacts of PAs and particularly of PES.
