Piracy Under International Law - United Nations

Piracy. Piracy threatens maritime security and the legitimate uses of the seas for peaceful purposes and the freedom of navigation. A 2008 report by the International Maritime Organization found 4,821 incidents of modern piracy and maritime armed robbery in the period 1984 to 2008. In these incidents 6 crew were killed, 42 assaulted, 774 held hostage and 38 crew are unaccounted for.
