Open radical prostatectomy The surgeon makes a cut in the lower tummy (abdomen), so they can remove the whole prostate. Or sometimes they remove the prostate through a cut they make in the area between the scrotum and the back passage, called the perineum.

Radical prostatectomy can be performed by an open approach (shown in the picture on the left) or using a minimally-invasive approach called robotic-assisted laparoscopic radical prostatectomy (RALP), shown in the picture on the right. Open radical prostatectomy. Your surgeon makes an incision in your lower abdomen, from below your navel to just above your pubic bone. After carefully dissecting the prostate gland from surrounding nerves and blood vessels, the surgeon removes the prostate along with nearby tissue. The incision is then closed with sutures.

Open radical prostatectomy, or complete removal of the prostate gland, is a surgery performed to treat prostate cancer. An open surgery is one where a short incision is made to allow the surgeon to see the site and insert surgical tools. During all radical prostatectomies, surrounding tissues may be removed, including lymph nodes and fat around the prostate.

The use of the robot to perform the laparoscopic radical prostatectomy, robotic-assisted radical prostatectomy, is currently the most common method to perform a radical prostatectomy. Compared to open radical prostatectomy, robot assisted laparoscopic radical prostatectomy is associated with less postoperative discomfort and sooner return to full activity, as well as less intraoperative blood loss with comparable outcomes regarding urinary continence and erectile function.

Radical prostatectomy involves the surgical removal of the entire prostate gland and the seminal vesicles. Recently the open operation has been challenged by laparoscopic and robotic techniques. However, making the transition to this new technology is not an easy option.

Side Effects of Prostatectomy Impotence and incontinence are the most common side effects of the radical prostatectomy. When the doctor removes the catheter two to three weeks after the surgery, patients will notice leakage. Many researchers dispute the exact number of patients who experience incontinence.

Risks and Complications of Prostatectomy

Hugh H. Young MD in collaboration with William Stewart Halsted MD developed the open, radical and perineal prostatectomies in 1904 at Johns Hopkins Brady Urological Institute, the first version of the procedure that became generally feasible. The Irish surgeon Terence Millin, MD (1903–1980) developed the radical retropubic prostatectomy in 1945.

For more complex circumstances, an open surgery may be a more appropriate option than a robotic surgery. A prostatectomy takes about two hours. You will be under general anesthesia, so you'll be completely asleep. During the surgery, your doctor will: Make a small incision to gain access to your prostate. Remove the prostate.
