In a Socratic Seminar activity, students help one another understand the ideas, issues, and values reflected in a text through a group discussion format. Students are responsible for facilitating their group discussion around the ideas in the text; they shouldn't use the discussion to assert their opinions or prove an argument.

Teaching Strategy: Socratic Seminar | Facing History

The National Paideia Center, which has developed extensive materials on using seminars in classrooms, defines a Socratic seminar as a 'collaborative, intellectual dialogue facilitated with open-ended questions about a text.' Through a Socratic Seminar, students will be able to gain a deeper understanding of the novel (through chapter 6) through discussion in a student-run/student-based method of instruction. Students will answer both interpretive and evaluative questions concerning important issues in the novel (people's need to belong, the theme of change, etc) and in real life.

Assessing effectiveness: Socratic seminars require assessment that respects the central nature of student-centered inquiry to their success. The most global measure of success is reflection, both on the part of the teacher and students, on the degree to which text-centered student talk dominated the time and work of the session.
