The taming of my tongue required that I remove myself from a situation causing temptation; and that ' s not to say that this cured me of the inclination, but it did limit it, giving me more time to use my tongue in the way described in Psalm 35:28, and affording me more mental space with which to meditate on God ' s Word and to, gradually, be changed by it.

Bible Reflections: The Taming of the Tongue - Bible ...

2. To tame the tongue, we must recognize its power for good or for evil (3:3-5a). James uses two analogies here to make the point that the tongue is small, but mighty: the bit and the rudder. A bit is a relatively small instrument, but when you put it into a horse ' s mouth, you can control the entire horse. The same thing is true of a ship ' s rudder.

We need to think before we speak. The Bible teaches, "My dearly loved brothers, understand this: everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak, and slow to anger, for man's anger does not accomplish God's righteousness." James 1:19-20 (HCSB) Guard against engaging the tongue without engaging the mind. Take a moment before you speak.
