Its objective is to restore and maintain the chemical, physical, and biological integrity of the nation's waters; recognizing the responsibilities of the states in addressing pollution and providing assistance to states to do so, including funding for publicly owned treatment works for the improvement of wastewater treatment; and maintaining the integrity of wetlands.

It served as a major revision of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1948, which had proven ineffective.

The Clean Water Act prevents direct discharges of pollutants into the waters of the United States through a program known as the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES").[iii] The NPDES program has very strict requirements, but it only applies to certain types of water pollution.
