What Is Cultural Imperialism

Cultural imperialism, the imposition by one usually politically or economically dominant community of various aspects of its own culture onto another nondominant community. While the term cultural imperialism did not emerge in scholarly or popular discourse until the 1960s, the phenomenon has a long historical record.

Cultural imperialism can refer to either the forced acculturation of a subject population, or to the voluntary embracing of a foreign culture by individuals who do so of their own free will. Since these are two very different referents, the validity of the term has been called into question.

Well, cultural imperialism takes place when one culture overtakes another in such a way that the latter ends up following a significant number of values, traditions, beliefs and influences of the former either completely or in a way which enmeshes the influences of the dominating culture inextricably with those of its own.
