In England, for example, the first Act of Parliament directed specifically against witchcraft was the act "De hæretico comburendo", passed at the instigation of Archbishop Thomas Arundel in 1401.

unreasonable that this scum of humanity, [witches], should be drawn chiefly from the feminine sex" (Nicholas Rémy, c. 1595) or "The Devil uses them so, because he knows that women love carnal pleasures, and he means to bind them to his allegiance by such agreeable provocations."
