If there was a Renaissance " rediscovery of the world and of man, " as the 19th-century historians Jules Michelet (in the seventh volume of his History of France) and Jacob Burckhardt (in The Civilization of the Renaissance in Italy [1860]) asserted, it can be found mainly in literature and art, influenced by the latest and most successful of a long series of medieval Classical revivals.

Arguably one of the key events in the Renaissance, in 1454, Johannes Gutenberg published the Gutenberg Bible, using a new printing press technology that would revolutionize European literacy. Lorenzo de Medici "The Magnificent" took over power in Florence in 1469; his rule is considered the high point of the Florentine Renaissance. Sixtus IV was appointed Pope in 1471, continuing the major building projects in Rome, including the Sistine Chapel.
